

Dear NWSA 89th Annual Meeting Registrants,

The 2018 Olympia meeting is coming up soon, and we wanted to share some logistical details with you.

The Proceedings document is posted on the website, along with other updated information including maps at www.northwestscience.org

- PARKING is FREE on campus for meeting registrants. You will need to check in with the kiosk staff at main campus entrance off Evergreen Parkway, and tell them you are attending the NWSA meeting.
- PURCE Hall will be the main center of the meeting, with Registration; Lost and Found, and most Technical Sessions.
- Registration opens at 7:30am on Wed Mar 28 in the Purce Hall Lobby on 1st floor, and will also be available at the Tuesday Evening Social.
- FishTale Brewery Warehouse is the location for the Tuesday Evening Social, across street from Brew Pub which is at 515 Jefferson St SE
- The Wednesday Banquet will be in LIB4300 as well as the NWSA Business Lunch on Thursday.
- The poster session is 4:00-6:15 pm on Wed in Purce Hall. Supplies to mount posters will be provided.
- Field trips on Friday morning will meet and depart from Parking Lot B (see field trip details for departure times); the Small Unmanned Aircraft field trip starts in Lab II 1223A and 1223B at 8 AM
- It is spring break at TESC, so campus food service is limited - two campus options are Einstein's Bagel Cafe and The Evergreen Bookstore. A map on the website shows food options nearby. We encourage you to consider bringing lunch for Wed, and Thurs if you did not sign up for Business luncheon.
- Electric car charging is available at east side of C-Lot : 2 stations part of [Blink network](#)
- There is a regular bus that runs every 15 minutes between campus and downtown
